Father says:

Let these three books remind us of the books YHVH is keeping. In one book is written the names of the Righteous, which we know is the Lamb's Book of Life. In a second book is written the names of the Wicked. And there is a third book in which the names of the Undecided are written.

All say:

We rejoice that we can say we are inscribed and sealed in the Lamb's Book of Life!

+ Erev Yom Teruah +

(Head/Beginning of the year)



+ Special Observance

All say:

Yom Teruah is observed as a memorial; a Day of Blowing the Shofar.

This day begins the seventh month;

a sacred, holy month when YHVH created the

This is the First Court Date for mankind to appear before the Judge of the world.

This is also the Day of the Kingship of Yeshua, the Day of Remembrance of all YHVH has done, and the Day of YHVH's Revelation that we may awake and rejoice in our salvation. Even now the LORD Yeshua has written our names

in His Book of Life.

+ Sound the Shofar

Father reads Numbers 29:1; Leviticus 23:23-25; Psalm 47.

Father blows the shofar announcing Yom Teruah EXCEPT on Sabbath.

(The shofar is sounded 100 times on Yom Teruah.)

+ The Candle Blessing

Mother (and daughter) light two white candles saying: Blessed are You, O YHVH our GOD,

King of the universe and eternity, Who has set us apart by Your Word and in Whose Name we light the festival lights.

> A menorah can be lighted (and additional lights). (The candles are allowed to extinguish themselves.)

+ Sanctification of Yom Teruah

Father fills and lifts cup in right hand, saying: Blessed are You, O YHVH our GOD, King of the universe and eternity, Who creates the fruit of the vine. The cup is passed and shared.
