11. I said in my haste, all men are deceitful and liars.
12. What shall I render to YHVH for all His Benefits toward me? How can I repay Him for all His Bountiful dealings?
13. I will lift up the Cup of Salvation and Deliverance and call on the Name of YHVH.
14. I will pay my vows to YHVH, yes, in the presence of His People.
15. Precious, important, and no light matter in the sight of YHVH is the death of His Saints, His Loving Ones.
16. O YHVH, truly I am Your servant; I am Your servant, the son of Your Handmaid; You have loosed my bonds.
17. I will offer to You the sacrifice of thanksgiving and will call on the Name of YHVH.
18. I will pay my vows to YHVH, yes, in the presence of His People.
19. In the Courts of YHVH's House--in the midst of you, O Jerusalem. Praise YHVH! Hallelujah!

## + Psalm 117

1. O praise YHVH, all you nations! Praise Him, all you people!
2. For His Mercy and Loving-kindness are great toward us, and the truth and faithfulness of YHVH endure forever. Praise YHVH! Hallelujah!

## + Psalm 118

1. O give thanks to YHVH, for He is good; for His Mercy and Loving-kindness endure forever!
2. Let Israel now say that His Mercy and Loving-kindness endure forever.
3. Let the house of Aaron, the priesthood, now say that His Mercy and Loving-kindness endure forever.
4. Let those now who reverently and worshipfully fear YHVH say that His Mercy and Loving-kindness endure forever.
5. Out of my distress I called upon YHVH; YHVH answered me and set me free and in a large place.
6. YHVH is on my side; I will not fear. What can man do to me?
7. YHVH is on my side and takes my part, He is among those who help me; therefore shall I see my desire established upon those who hate me.
8. It is better to trust and take refuge in YHVH than to put confidence in man.
9. It is better to trust and take refuge in YHVH than to put confidence in princes.
10. All nations, the surrounding tribes, compassed me about, but in the Name of YHVH I will cut them off!
11. They compassed me about, yes, they surrounded me on every side; but in the Name of YHVH I will cut them off!
12. They swarmed about me like bees, they blaze up and are extinguished like a fire of thorns; in the Name of YHVH I will cut them off!
13. You, my adversary, thrust sorely at me that I might fall, but YHVH helped me.
14. YHVH is my Strength and Song; and He has become my Salvation.
15. The voice of rejoicing and salvation is in the tents and private dwellings of the uncompromisingly righteous: the Right Hand of YHVH does valiantly and achieves strength!
