#### + Yeshua's Circumcision

Father reads Luke 2:21:

On the eighth day, when it was time to circumcise Him, He was named YESHUA, the name the angel had given Him before He had been conceived.

Father also reads Luke 2:25-38:

Now there was a man in Jerusalem called Simeon, who was righteous and devout. He was waiting for the consolation of Israel, and Ruach HaKodesh was upon him.

It had been revealed to him by Ruach HaKodesh that he would not die before he had seen YHVH's Anointed.

Moved by Ruach HaKodesh, he went into the temple courts. When the parents brought in the child Yeshua to do for him what the custom of the Law required, Simeon took Him in his arms and praised YHVH, saying: "Sovereign LORD, as You have promised, You now dismiss Your servant in peace. For my eyes have seen Your Salvation, which You have prepared in the sight of all people, a light for revelation to the Gentiles and for glory to Your people Israel."

The Child's father and mother marveled at what was said about Him.

Then Simeon blessed them and said to Mary, His mother: "This Child is destined to cause the falling and rising of many in Israel, and to be a sign that will be spoken against, so that the thoughts of many hearts will be revealed. And a sword will pierce your own soul too."

There was also a prophetess, Anna, the daughter of Phanuel, of the tribe of Asher. She was very old; she had lived with her husband seven years after her marriage, and then was a widow until she was eighty-four. She never left the temple but worshipped night and day, fasting and praying.

Coming up to them at that very moment, she gave thanks to YHVH and spoke about the Child to all who were looking forward to the redemption of Jerusalem.

May our suggestions, loving discipline, and example always direct them to You.

We offer this prayer in Yeshua's Name, Who is Your Word to us.

### + The Family Blessing

Father AND the children bless the family:
YHVH bless you and keep you.
YHVH make His Face to shine upon you
and be gracious unto you.
YHVH turn His Face toward you
and give you His Shalom.
